Inspire Internship Science Camp

The venue of the programme is Mar Gregorios Conference Hall, Mar Ivanios College. Registration will start at 7.00 AM on 3rd January 2018 in Mar Gregorios Renewal Centre, Mar Ivanios Vidya Nagar where the accommodation for the participants is arranged. Participants are reminded to collect their kit at the time of registration.

General Instructions to the Participants:

1. The duration of the camp will be 5 days commencing from 3rd January 2018, Wednesday. The programme will start with an opening ceremony followed by scientific sessions and will end on 7th January 2018, Sunday by 3.30 PM with a valedictory function.
2. The camp will be purely residential and registered participants will not be permitted to leave the venue until the camp is over.
3. The participants will be provided second sleeper class train fare/bus fare for to and fro journey from their School to Mar Ivanios College and their boarding will be taken care of absolutely free of cost. Travel ticket should be produced for the reimbursement of travel fare.
4. The participants need not pay any fee either to the School or to the Organizers.
5. Participants should get up early in the morning by 6.00 AM during the camp days.
6. The programme for each day will start by 8.30 AM and end by 8.00 PM. Participants are strongly advised to go to bed by 10 PM.
7. Each student should be able to participate actively and interact with the Mentors/Resource persons especially during the interaction hours in order to make the programme alive and interesting.
8. Participants are advised to be punctual and self-disciplined during camp period.
9. Participants are advised to bring one or two bed sheets, one pillow cover, one stainless steel plate and glass.
10. Each participant should keep a strict vigil to ensure that the assets of the camp venue are kept in good conditions.
11. It is strongly advised not to bring any valuable ornaments/things to the camp. Organizers will not take any responsibility for the loss or damage of the same.

12. Use of Mobile phone is strictly prohibited during the class/ interaction time. However, participants are allowed to use the mobile phone from 8 PM to 10 PM.
13. Participants are requested to bring their school **identity card and copy of the 10th mark list.**
14. They should produce one **stamp size photo** at the registration counter to prepare their id card.
