06 January	Last date for uploading of CE marks - Semester 5.

Note (as per University guidelines):

In each semester, classes are to be engaged for 90 teaching days or for 450 hours. If any of the dates, prescribed in the calendar happens to be a holiday, the next working day shall be the prescribed date for the academic event noted against it.
