<u>For the Waiting list candidates:</u> Once their admission is confirmed (candidates will be intimated the confirmation through E-mail/College website) they can remit the College/University admission fee through online mode on or before 11:59 PM, 15th June 2026 to confirm their admission. If you fail to make the fee payment before the above said time, your admission will be cancelled and you have no further claim for admission to that seat. [If the candidate 'ACCEPT' the allotment he/she has to <u>wait for the confirmation of admission</u> . Important Instructions

- 1) Omissions and errors in the Trial/Final Rank list should be brought to the notice of the Principal by e-mail (admission@mic.ac.in) on or before 05.00 pm, 8th June / 11th June 2026 respectively. No changes will be entertained after that. **E-mail should be sent from your registered e-mail id only.**
- 2) For allotment details, check the 'Candidate Login' page provided in the home page/FYUGP admission portal of the College website (www.mic.ac.in)
- 3) When a candidate gets allotment he/she should follow the below steps:
 - a) Those candidates in the merit list (confirmed allotment) can pay their fees on or before 11.59 PM on 13th June 2026. If the candidate declines or does not respond to the allotment within the stipulated time he/she will not be considered for further allotments in that particular subject under that particular quota.
 - b) Those candidates in the waiting list should check their allotment status through their Candidate login and **ACCEPT/ DECLINE** the allotment. If the candidate **ACCEPT** the allotment he/she has to wait for the confirmation of his/her allotment from the College. **Candidates who are in the Merit list can pay their fees immediately.**
 - c) If a candidate gets the first allotment in a subject of his/her second or third choice he/she can accept/decline it and wait for his/her higher choices in the succeeding allotments. If there is any fee change in the higher allotment the candidate should remit the excess fee. Balance fees will be refunded after the closure of admissions on their request through an e-mail send to (admission@mic.ac.in)
 - d) If a candidate who took admission wants to cancel his/her admission later should inform the same to the Principal by e-mail (info@mic.ac.in).
 - e) **The admission process will be complete only after the physical verification of their original certificates, PTA fund and any other additional fees will be collected at the time of interview with the students and their parents.**
 - f) **Payment of College/University fees will not be a claim for the confirmation of admission. Any discrepancy in the submitted certificates/documents at the time of physical verification may lead to the cancellation of the candidate's admission. .**
 - g) The allotment dates of Sports quota candidates will be published later. **Sports Quota applicants should submit a hard copy of their performance certificate at the physical education department by hand or by post on or before the last date of submission of the application.**
