- This option is only for students who joined in any college in 2024 or before, but under FYUGP scheme. Only students who have studied the proposed Major as a Minor or MDC in Semester 1 or Semester 2 will be eligible to apply for Major Change.
- Students should have successfully completed and passed all courses in Semester 1 and 2, for being eligible to be considered for Major change from other colleges.
- There will be an Entrance Test for the applicants. Merit will be allotted based on the grades obtained in Semester 1 and 2 (50%) and the scores obtained in the entrance examination conducted by the college (50%).
- The entrance test will consist of questions from the discipline to which the applicant proposes to join as Major and will be of the Academic Level 100-199.
- Interested students may apply online at the college admission portal. Link: www.mic.ac.in
- The application should include a certificate from the Principal of the college where the student is currently enrolled, stating that the student has not been involved in activities such as ragging or similar misconduct and that the student has not faced any disciplinary action in the college. A certificate from the Head of the Department also is necessary regarding the attendance regularity, academic discipline, curricular and co-curricular interests, and potential of the student.
- Last Date of receiving application online: 2 July 2025.
- Date of Entrance Test: 4 July 2025. (Venue: The college)
