- 1. The total SCPA/ Mark secured by each successful candidate is shown along with the Register number of the candidate.
- 2. In the case of First Degree Programme under CBCSS and CSS, for the successful completion of a Semester, a candidate has to score a minimum SCPA of 4.00 (E Grade). A minimum of 35% mark is required for CE and ESE separately for a course pass and a minimum of SCPA 4 is required for a pass in a Semester for candidates of 2019 Admission onwards. A minimum of 40% marks (E Grade) is required for passing a course with a separate minimum of 35% (E Grade) for End Semester Evaluation (ESE) and for Continuous Evaluation (CE) for candidates of 2017 2018 Admissions
- 3. In the case of Post Graduate Examination for successful completion of a semester, a candidate shall secure a minimum of 40% marks for ESE and 50% marks for CE and ESE together for each subject in the semester for candidates belonging to 2017 Admission onwards. No separate minimum is required for CE marks.
- 4. The draft Statement of Marks will be obtained from the College Website shortly.

- 5. Candidates who desire to apply for Scrutiny/ Revaluation of their answer scripts shall apply Online and submit the print out of the application alongwith the receipt of the prescribed fees to the office of the Controller of Examination. The Online registration will be open from 13th March 2024 and the last date for submission of application shall be 01st April 2024. No Revaluation is applicable for P.G. Degree Courses.
- 6. Students who apply for scrutiny are eligible to apply for revaluation of that answer scripts within 5 days from the date of scrutiny of their answer scripts.
- 7. The prescribed fees (Rs. 500/- per paper for Revaluation, Rs. 100/- per paper for Scrutiny along with Rs. 30/- for Online registration) shall be remitted.
