PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT 2015-2016

May God be glorified and may peace, prosperity and harmony prevail among humankind. It is with a sense of profound gratitude to God that I present my second report as the Principal of Mar Ivanios College. After 66 years of excellence in higher education, the leading position of the College in the higher education scenario gives me immense satisfaction and confidence to place before you the report of the activities of the academic year 2015-16.

The Academic year began on June 1st 2015. Both degree and PG admissions were conducted by the college and first year classes began on 29th June 2015 and 31st July 2015 for UG and PG students respectively. There were 2200 students on the roll. The strength of the permanent teaching faculty was 86 and that of guest lecturers was about 25. The administrative and support staff comprised of 37 permanent members and 20 temporary/contract members. Dr. K. L. Anandavally served as the Vice-Principal, Rev. Fr. Sheen Palakuzhy as the Bursar and Dr. K. S. Mathew as the Controller of Examinations.

Transfers and Appointments

Dr. A.O. Roy, Associate Professor, Dept. of Malayalam was appointed as Principal, Pazhassiraja College, Pulppally and was relieved to take up the prestigious position. Rev. Fr. Tom Antony, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Commerce, was relieved to join SB College Changanasserry. Three faculty members Dr. George Lukose, Dr. Rejitha L.R. and Dr. R. Selwyn Joseyphus joined the staff upon transfer from St. John's College, Anchal. Four new permanent faculty members were appointed during 2014-15: Dr. Sajith Kurian and Ms. Binimole Mary Mathew (Chemistry), Ms. Deepamol Thomas (Journalism) and Mr. Sajeesh T. (Botany). Four members joined the Non-teaching staff: Mr. Renjith R.S., Mr. Roy George, Mr. Anub Raj R. and Ms. Maria Jyothi Mathew. Dr. Suboj Babykutty rejoined the faculty of Zoology after his Post Doctoral studies in the Harvard Medical School. Mrs. Kala Shibu joined as Counselling Psychologist in the college from July 2015.

Dr. Sumol Varghese and Ms. Suju Skaria took charge as the Head of the Dept of Chemistry and Botany respectively at the beginning of the academic year. Ms. Teena Jude Francis, Associate Professor, Department of English, was elected as College Council Secretary and the other elected members to the Council were Dr. Georgi P. Daniel (Physics), Dr. P. I. Paul(Zoology), Dr. Sam Solomon (Physics), and Ms. Regina Sibi Cleetus (Commerce). Dr. Varghese Abraham (Mathematics) was nominated as the Staff Secretary.

Retirement

Six of our eminent teachers who formed an integral part of Mar Ivanios family for more than 30 years bid adieu to the college last year. Dr. K.L. Anandavally, who had been the Vice-Principal of the College for the last two years retired from the Dept. of Mathematics along with Head of the Department Dr. James Alexander and Associate Professor Dr. Varghese Abraham. Dr. Jadu Samuel retired from the Dept of Chemistry. Dr. Biji James, Head of the Department of Commerce and Dr. K. S. Mathew, Dept of Physics and first Controller of Examinations, retired this year after distinguished and meritorious service in this college.

Five members of the non teaching staff Sri. V. T. Thomas, Senior Supdt of the College, Sri Retnakaran, Sri Varghese John, Mr. K. Surendran and Sri. A. Babu retired from the Administrative wing. The College Community remembers with gratitude the services rendered by these eminent staff members.

Obituary

A few of our former faculty members were called to eternal rest during 2015-16. Prof K.J.Thomas, former faculty member of the Dept. of Botany died on 15th August 2015. Dr. Varghese M. Mathunny, former HoD of Economics and former Principal, St. John's College, Anchal left for his heavenly abode on 6th September 2015. Rev. Fr. Philip C. Pantholil (101), former Bursar and faculty member of the college, was called to eternal rest on 15th November 2015; Rev. Fr. Oommen Ayyaneth (92), former faculty member of Dept. of Malayalam, died in the Lord on 19th November 2015. Prof. Tito K. Cherian, former faculty member of the Dept. of English, died in the Lord on 21st January 2016 and Prof M. S. George, former faculty member of Chemistry, on 26th January 2016. Rev. Sr. Mary Mathew D.M., former faculty member of the Dept. of Chemistry, was called to her eternal abode on 17th March 2016. Mr. D. Japasingh who rendered 33 years of committed service to the college as administrative staff died on 27.06.2015. May the souls of the departed rest in peace.

Meetings

Three meetings of the Governing Council were held during 2015-16 on 11/09/2015, 06/10/2015, and 24/02/2016. Academic Council held two meetings on 21/12/2015 and 29/03/2016. Boards of Studies in different subjects conducted two meetings each. DDU KAUSHAL Advisory Board met twice during 2015-16 on 23/11/2015 and 28/03/2016. College Council and General Staff meeting were conducted on different occasions as and when it was necessary to discuss various issues. I thank all the members of the above bodies for the wholehearted support and inputs extended for the benefit of the college.

Degree and PG Results 2015 - 2016.

Mar Ivanios College students performed meritoriously in the University examinations of the last non-autonomous batch conducted in April 2016. The batch produced 100% pass and received the international certification from Cambridge University. This is the second year in succession that our students are achieving the commendable 100% pass.
