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Important Instructions

- 1) Omissions and errors in the allotment should be brought to the notice of the Principal by e-mail (it.admin@mic.ac.in) on or before 11 September 5.00 pm. No changes will be entertained after that. **E-mails should be send from your registered e-mail id only.**
- 2) For allotment details, candidates can login to their account through the 'Candidate's Login' or through the 'Allotment Status link' provided in the home page of the College website (www.mic.ac.in)
- 3) When a candidate gets allotment he/she should follow the below steps:
 - a) First **ACCEPT** or **DECLINE** the allotment. If the candidate declines or does not respond to the allotment within the stipulated time he/she will not be considered for further allotments in that particular subject under that particular quota.
 - b) If a candidate receives more than one allotment he/she should **opt for one allotment only**, of his choice.
 - c) If the candidate **ACCEPT** the allotment he/she has to upload the self-attested, duly signed, scanned copies of the declaration forms and their relevant certificates mentioned in the Google form provided and **wait for the confirmation of admission. Once their admission is confirmed** (candidates will be intimated the confirmation through SMS/email) **they can remit the College/University admission fee** through online mode for confirmation of allotment.
 - d) If a candidate gets the allotment in a subject of his/her second or third choice he/she can accept/decline it and wait for his/her higher choices in the succeeding allotments. If there is any fee change in the higher allotment the candidate should remit the excess fee. Balance fees will be refunded after the closure of admissions on their request through an e-mail send to (it.admin@mic.ac.in)
 - e) If a candidate who took admission wants to cancel his/her admission later should inform the same to the Principal by e-mail (info@mic.ac.in).
 - f) **The admission process will be complete only after the physical verification of their original certificates. PTA fund and any other additional fees will be collected at the time of interview with the students and their parents.**
 - g) **Payment of College/University fees will not be a claim for the confirmation of admission. Any discrepancy in the submitted certificates/documents at the time of physical verification may lead to the cancellation of the candidate's admission. .**
 - h) The allotment dates of PWD (Persons with Disabilities) and Sports quota candidates will be published later. Shortlisted Sports candidates will be intimated by SMS/e-mail for uploading their sports certificates.
